

A By-law for the Regulation of Blasting.

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :-

1. No person shall within the limits of the Municipality of Burnaby blast with dynamite, gunpowder or other explosive without first having obtained a written permit so to do from the Engineer of the said Corporation, such permit to state the name and address of the person to whom such permit is issued, the location of such blasting, the date of issue and date of expiry of said permit.
2. Any such permit may at any time be cancelled by the said Engineer of the Corporation giving written notice of such cancellation to the holder of the permit. Such notice may be given by mailing the same to the holder of said permit at the address stated in such permit.
3. All applications for permits shall be made in writing to the said Engineer and the granting of any such permit shall be entirely at the discretion of the said Engineer.
4. Notwithstanding the granting of any such permit no person shall within the limits of the said Municipality blast with Dynamite, Gunpowder or other Explosive on Sunday or at any time between Sunset of one day and Sunrise of the day following, or at any time when owing to fog or other state of the atmosphere ordinary objects are not plainly discernible at a distance of 100 yards in every direction from the place where such blasting is being done.
5. No person shall blast in the vicinity of inhabited dwelling houses within the limits of the said Municipality

without giving due warning to the inhabitants therein within a radius of 200 yards from the location of such blasting and if the blasting is to take place on or near any road, roads, highway or highways, within the said Municipality two men must be placed on such road, roads, highway or highways to give proper warning to foot-passengers and traffic along such road, roads, highway or highways.

6. Any person guilty of an infraction of this by-law shall, upon conviction thereof, before the Reeve, Police Magistrate, or any Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction within the said Municipality, be liable at the discretion of the said Reeve, Police Magistrate, Justice of the Peace convicting as aforesaid to a penalty not exceeding \$100.00 together with the costs of the prosecution and in default of payment forthwith, it shall be lawful for the Reeve, Police Magistrate, or Justice of the Peace convicting as aforesaid to issue a Warrant under his hand and seal to levy the said Penalty and costs by distress and sale of the offender's goods and chattels and in default of such distress it shall and may be lawful for the Reeve, Police Magistrate or Justice convicting as aforesaid to commit the offender to prison for any period not exceeding 30 days with or without Hard Labour.

7. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNBY BLASTING REGULATION BY-LAW 1911"
