

BY-LAW NO. 126

A By-Law to fix a scale for Police salaries in the Municipality of Burnaby.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, enacts as follows:-

1. The remuneration to be paid to Police Constables, other than the Chief of Police, shall be according to the following scale, namely,- For the first year of employment \$70.00 per month.  
For the second year of employment \$80.00 per month.  
For the third year of employment \$90.00 per month.  
And for the fourth and subsequent years \$100.00 per month.
2. This By-Law shall not be construed so as to reduce the remuneration at present received by any Police Constable employed by the Municipality, but such Police Constable shall continue to receive the salary which he is now receiving until such time as he shall be entitled to an increased salary, under the scale mentioned in Section 1 hereof.
3. This By-Law may be cited as the "Burnaby Police Salaries By-Law 1912".
