

MUNICIPALITY OF BURNABY

"Burnaby Road Tax By-law 1912"

By-law No. ~~120~~ 130....

WHEREAS by Subsection 158 of Section 53 of the "Municipal Act" power is given to the council of a district municipality to levy and collect road tax.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that a road tax shall be levied and collected in the District of ~~Nurb~~- Burnaby -

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows, -

1. Every male person between the ages of twenty-one and sixty residing for two weeks within the Municipality of Burnaby whose name is not entered on the assessment roll of the said District of Burnaby, or who is not a resident householder with a family, shall pay a road tax of Two Dollars (\$2.00) each year which amount shall be paid to the person duly authorised by the Council to collect the same.
2. For the collection and recovery of the said tax the provisions of the "Municipal Act" shall apply and be used.
3. This By-law shall take effect from the 1st day of April 1912.
4. The "Burnaby Road Tax By-law 1908" as amended by the "Burnaby Road Tax By-law 1908 Amendment By-law 1911" is hereby repealed.
5. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY ROAD TAX BY-LAW 1912."
