"Burnaby Road Tax By-law 1912"

By-law No. 130...

WHEREAS by Subsection 158 of Section 53 of the "Municipal Act" power is given to the council of a district municipality to levy and collect road tax.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that a road tax shall be levied and collected in the District of Nurb- Burnaby -

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows. -

- and sixty residing for two weeks within the Municipality of Burnaby whose name is not entered on the assessment roll of the said District of Burnaby, or who is not a resident householder with a family, shall pay a road tax of Two Dollars (\$2.00) each year which amount shall be paid to the person duly authorised by the Council to collect the same.
- 2. For the collection and recovery of the said tax the provisions of the "Municipal Act" shall apply and be used.
- 3. This By-law shall take effect from the 1st day of April 1912.
- 4. The "Burnaby Road Tax By-law 1908" as amended by the "Burnaby Road Tax By-law 1908 Amendment By-law 1911" is hereby repealed.
- 5. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY ROAD TAX BY-LAW 1912."
