

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY :

BY-LAW NO. 136.

A By-law to amend the "BURNABY MAPS APPROVAL BY-LAW 1912"

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of
the District of Burnaby enacts as follows, -

1. "Burnaby Maps Approval By-law 1912" is hereby
amended by inserting after paragraph 13. the following :-

"13a. When the tentative plan has been approved
by the Council and before final approval of the plan the
owner of the lands shall slash the roads or streets to the
width of Twenty Feet shown by the said plan and rough grade
the said Streets or roads to the satisfaction of the
Municipal Engineer."

2. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY MAPS APPROVAL
BY-LAW 1912 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1912."
