By-law No. 139.

A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAWS NOS. 120 AND 121.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, enacts as follows:-

1. That By-law No. 120, known as "Burnaby Roads Improvement Debenture By-law 1912" and By-law No. 121, known as "Burnaby Sidewalks Extension By-law 1912" be and the same are hereby repealed.


2. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Repealing By-law 1912."

TO HIS HONOUR

THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:

THE UNDERSIGNED has the honour to report for  
the consideration of the Council that the Municipal Council  
of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby finally  
adopted on the 22nd. day of January, 1912, By-law No. 120  
of the By-laws of the said Corporation, to enable the  
Corporation to raise by way of loan \$250,000.00 for street  
purposes, and on the same day By-law No. 121, to enable the  
Corporation to raise \$50,000.00 for sidewalks within the  
Municipality.

THAT the By-laws duly received the assent of the  
Electors.

THAT through a mistake by the Municipal Clerk  
more than 21 days were allowed to elapse between the passage  
of the By-laws and the submission to the electors and in  
this respect the By-laws do not comply with the provisions in  
that behalf of the "Municipal Act".

THAT on the 23rd. day of September, 1912, the  
said Council passed a By-law, numbered 139, repealing said  
By-laws 120 and 121.

THAT section 127 of the "Municipal Act" provides  
that no such By-law shall be repealed without the consent  
of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council and such consent is now  
requested by the Municipal Council.

THE UNDERSIGNED has therefore the honour to  
recommend that the consent of His Honour the Lieutenant-Governor  
in Council be given to By-law No. 139, repealing By-laws Nos.  
120 and 121, of the By-laws of the Corporation of the District  
of Burnaby.

AND that a Certified Copy of this Minute, if  
approved, be transmitted to Messrs. Monnarrie, Martin and  
Cassady, of the City of New Westminster, the Solicitors  
for the said Corporation.
