CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 147

A By-law to amend "Burnaby Blasting Regulation By-law 1912."

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. Clause 6 of the "Burnaby Blasting Regulation By-law 1912" is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:6. "A fee of \$2.50 per annum shall be charged to each person to whom license shall be issued to make clearing land his business. Bona fide settlers engaged in clearing their home sites may obtain license on the following scale:One month 25¢; two months 50¢; three months 75¢; six months \$1.50; nine months \$2.00. Corporation employees in corporation day labour work shall not be required to pay license fee."

2. Clause 5 of said By-law is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:-

"No person shall blast in the vicinity of a power line until after the expiration of forty-eight (48) hours notice in writing which shall have been given by him to the power company and to the Municipal Wiring Inspector or electrician that blasting is to be done."

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY BLASTING REGULATION BY-LAW 1912 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1913."
