

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

By-Law No. 140...

A By-Law to fix a scale for Police Salaries in the Municipality of Burnaby.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :-

1. The remuneration of the Chief Constable of the District of Burnaby shall be One Hundred and forty Dollars (\$140.00) per month and the salary of the Sergeant shall be One Hundred and ten Dollars (\$110.00) per month.

2. The remuneration to be paid to Police Constables other than the Chief of Police and the Sergeant shall be according to the following scale :-

For the first year of employment Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) per month;

For the second year of employment Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00) per month;

For the third year of employment Ninety-five Dollars (\$95.00) per month; and

For the fourth and subsequent years of employment One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month.

Provided that constables stationed away from headquarters or sub-stations shall be allowed an additional Five Dollars (\$5.00) per month in lieu of quarters.


3. The above salaries shall be deemed to have been in effect from the First day of February, 1913.

4. By-law No. 126 "Burnaby Police Salaries By-law 1912" and By-law No. 139 "Burnaby Police Salaries Re-Adjustment By-law, 1912" are hereby repealed.


5. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY POLICE SALARIES BY-LAW, 1913."
