

CORPORATION OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 164.

A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE "POLES AND WIRES REGULATION BY-LAW 1908".

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. The said "Poles and Wires Regulation By-law 1908" is hereby amended by adding the following at the end of Section 1 thereof:-

(1a.) Where any poles have been placed upon any Street, Highway or Lane within the Municipality and upon construction of permanent sidewalks or permanent works upon such Street, Highway or Lane it is found necessary or expedient to replace the same the Municipal Council may by resolution require such poles to be replaced in such position as the said Council may consider necessary by reason of such construction of permanent sidewalks or permanent works and the owner of such poles shall replace the said poles in accordance with such resolution within **thirty** days after being served with notice thereof in writing.

(1b.) In default of the said poles being replaced by the owner thereof in accordance with the provisions of the preceding section hereof the Council may replace the said poles at the expense of the owner thereof and may recover the expense thereof with interest at the rate of six per centum per annum with costs from such owner in like manner as municipal taxes.

(1c.) All construction work connected with the placing of poles and wires and the replacing of poles shall be carried out under the supervision of and to the satisfaction


of the Municipal Engineer of the Corporation of
the District of Burnaby.


(ld.) Any Company, Corporation or person guilty of
a violation of any of the provisions of this By-law
shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding the sum of
One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and costs.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "POLES AND WIRES
REGULATION BY-LAW 1908, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1913."
