CORPORATION OF BURNABY

By-law No 189.

A By-law to extend the time for the levy of taxes by sale of lands.

WHERMAS by Section 245 of the "Lunicipal Act" it is provided that if the Collector shall not deem it advisable to exercise the right of action conferred by Section 275 of the said Act for the recovery of unpaid taxes he shall, on a day to be fixed by the Council between the 15th day of June and the 15th day of September in each year levy such delinquent taxes and subsequent taxes in arrear together with all costs, interest and charges by sale of the lands in his Lunicipality of the persons liable for the said delinquent taxes provided that the Council may in any year by by-law passed for that purpose extend the time for the levy of taxes by sale of lands under this Section to the year next following.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to so extend the said time.

THE Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :-

- 1. That the time for the levy of taxes by sale of lands in the Municipality of Burnaby under said Section 245 of the "Municipal Act" be and the same is hereby extended to the year 1915.
- 2. Nothing in this by-law contained shall be deemed in any way to extend the time for payment of taxes or to affect, limit or abridge any of the other remedies of the Municipality for collection or enforcing payment thereof.
