CORPORATION OF THE DESTRICT OF BURNABY

A By-law to divert a portion of the dastings-Barnet Road in the Eunicipality of Burnaby.

Act" i. is provided inter alia that in every municipality the council may make by-laws for establishing, opening, making, preserving, improving, repairing, widening, altering, diverting or stopping up roads, streets, squares, alleys, lames, bridges, or other public thoroughfares within the boundaries of the Municipality or the jurisdiction of the Council.

AND WHEREAS by Subsection 202 of Section 54 of the "Nunicipal Act" it is provided that in every municipality the Council may make by-laws for disposing of a public street or highway or any portion thereof whenever deemed necessary is exchange for adjacent or contiguous lands acquired or expropriated for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, or diverting any public street or highway and to execute deeds for property so exchanged when authorized so to do by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

AND MERRAS it is doesed advisable and desirable to divert a portion of the Hastings-Barnet Road in through District Lots Iwo Hundred and Inirteen (213) and Iwo Jundred and fourteen (214) in the Manicipality of Burnaby.

AND THEREAS the North Pacific Lumber Company, Limited, an Extra-Provincial Company, licensed to carry on business in the Erovince of British Columbia, with dead Office situate at Barnet, British Columbia, has agreed to grant and convey to the Municipality the lands required for such diversion

through said lots being those portions of District Lots .wo Hundred and thirteen (213) and .wo hundred and fourteen (214) Group one (1) New Mostminster District hereinafter more particularly described in exchange for the lands within the limits of said lots To hundred and thirteen (213) and two Hundred and fourteen (214) now established as a road.

AND WHITHHAS for the purpose aforesaid it is necessary to close those parts of the Mastings-Barnet Road now or here-tofore established and more particularly hereinafter described.

THE Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore enacts as follows :-

established and opened over the lands and premises described as follows: - ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being, in the Province of British Columbia, in the District of New Westminster, Group One (1), being composed of a portion of District Lots Two Mundred and thirteen (212) and wo hundred and fourteen (214), and which may be more earticularly known and described as follows, that is to say:-

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centre line of said road allowance with the Westerly boundary of said District Lot two Mundred and fourteen; said point being Southerly and distant 334.2 feat from a post planted at the North West corner of said District Lot two Mundred and fourteen (214); themse following the centre line of said road allowance along the courses hereinafter described:-

North 89 degrees 14 minutes East, 164.5 feet; South 86 degrees 27 minutes East, 599.0 feet; South 72 degrees 32 minutes East, 1885.9 feet; South 86 degrees 04 minutes East, 198.3 feet; South 75 degrees 22 minutes East, 278.3

feet; South 67 degrees 21 minutes 2ast, 190.8 feet; South 61 degrees 56 minutes Hast, 692.4 feet; South 78 degrees 54 minutes Bast, 189.8 feet; North 84 degrees 08 minutes East, 521.0 feet; South 82 degrees 33 minutes East, 781.0 feet; South 86 degrees 57 minutes Bast, 275.9 feet; and North 72 dogrees 04 minutes Mast, 205.0 feet more or less to the intersection with the Basterly boundary of said District Lot 213, said point of intersection being Boutherly and distant 434.16 feet from a post planted at the intersection of the Bortherly boundary of the Consdian Pacific Railway Company's Right of Way with the said Easterly boundary of District Lot 213; and said centre line of road allowance as hereinbefore described having a parallel width of 33 feet on each side of centre line and containing Eight (8) 28/100 acres be the same more or less as shewn coloured red on the plan attached hereto.

2. The Corporation of the District of Burnaby declares closed and stopped up that portion of the Hastings-Barnet Road resumed and established under and by virtue of the "Burnaby Road Appropriation By-law 1906" described as follows: ALL AND AINSULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the rovince of British Columbia, in the District of New Westminster, Group one (1), being composed of a portion of District Lots two dundred and thirteen (213) and two dundred and fourteen (214), and which may be more particularly known and described as follows, that is to say:-

centre line of said road allowance with the Westerly boundary of said District Lot 214; said point of intersection being outherly and distant 287 feet from the post planted at the North West corner of said District Lot Two hundred and fourteen (214) themse following said centre line of

road allowance along the courses hereinafter described:-North 55 degrees Mast, 96.5 feet; Morth 70 degrees 49 minutes Bast. 74 feet; Borth 87 degrees 42 minutes Rast, 471.8 feet; South 50% degrees 18 minutes Rast, 540 fact; South 74 degrees 45 minutes Fast 138.6 feet to the point of a curve to the left; thence following a curve to the left having a radius of 231 fest, 148.4 feet to the intersection with a tangent; thence North 68 degrees 09 minutes East along said tangent 429.7 feet to a point, said point being Southerly and distant 18.9 feet measured at right angles thereto from the Southerly boundary of the Camadian Pacific Railw y Company's Right of Way; and having a parallel width of 33 feet on each side of said centre line as hereinbefore described: thence South 67 degrees 18 minutes Hast along a course, 302 feet to a point, said point being Southerly and distant 26 feet measure" at right angles thereto from the Southerly boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company's Right of Way; and being bounded along said course on the North by the Southerly boundary of the Canadian acific Railway Company's Right of Way. and on the South by a line Southerly and distant 24.5 feet measured at right angles thereto at the Testerly em. and 22.8 feat at the Basferly end of said course; Thence following the centre line of said road allowance along the courses here inafter described: - South 22 degrees 42 minutes West. 69 feet South 15 degrees 41 minutes East, 150.5 feet; and South 67 degrees 18 minutes Bast, 575 feet; and eaid road allowance having a parallel width of 20 feet on each side of said centre line; hence following said centre line of road allowance along the courses hereinafter described:-

South 28 degrees 26 minutes East, 220 feet; South 63 degrees 42 minutes East, 193 feet; South 29 degrees 16

minutes East, 69.6 feet; South 36 degrees 58 minutes East, 334.9 feet; South 65 degrees 58 minutes Mast, 111.5 feet; South 88 degrees 38 minutes Rast. 280.8 feet; South 81 degrees 38 minutes Bast, 196 feet; South 68 degrees 03 minutes Bast, 239 feet; South 56 degrees 47 minutes East, 141 feet; South 61 degrees 27 minutes Mast, 123 feet; outh 78 degrees 48 minutes Mast, 138.5 feet; South 87 Aegrees 52 minutes East, 153 feet; South 65 degrees 11 minutes Hast, 125.5 feet; South 81 degrees 29 minutes Bast, 183.8 feet; North 82 degrees 09 minutes East, 130.5 feet; North 68 degrees 42 minutes East, 130 feet; Morth 51 degrees 38 minutes Bast, 128.2 feet; North 52 degrees 08 minutes Rast, 111.8 feet; and North 63 degrees 40% minutes Bast. 80 feet more or less to the intersection with the Easterly boundary of said District Lot 213, said point of intersection being Southerly and distant 884.06 feet from a post planted at the intersection of the Mortherly boundary of the Canadian - acific Railway Company's right of way, with the Easterly boundary of said District hot 213, and said road allowance having a parallel of 33 feet on each side of said centre line of road allowance as her inbefore described, and containing 8-28/100 acres be the same more or less as shown outlines in yellow on the plan attaches hereto.

3. The Corporation of the District of Burnaby declares closed and stopped up that portion of the Mastings-Barnat Road as re-located and established on May 2nd, 1911, and described as follows: - ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Province of British Columbia, in the District of New Westminster, Group One (1), being composed of a portion of District Lots Iwo Mundred and thirteen (213) and Two hundred and fourteen (214), and which may be more

particularly known and described as follows, that is to say:-

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centre line of said road allowance on a tangent having a bearing of North 80 degrees 38 minutes East with the Testerly boundary of said District Lot 214, said point being Southerly and distant 334.2 feet from a post planted at the North Westerly corner of said District Lot 214; thence following the centre line of said road allowance along the courses hereinafter described:-

on a curve to the right having a radius of 1043 feet, 234.8 feet to the intersection of a tangent; thence South 87 degrees 27 minutes Bast along a tangent 358.2 feet to the point of a curve; thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 819 feet, 181.4 feet to the intersection with a tangent; thence South 74 degrees 45 minutes Bast along a tangent 409.5 feet to the point of a curve; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of SSI feet 148.4 feet to the intersection with a tangent; thence North 68 degrees 09 minutes Rast along a tangent 439.7 feet to a point, said point being Southerly and distant 18.9 feet measured at right angles thereto; from the Southerly boundary of the Uanadian Pacific Esilway Company's Right of Way: and said road allowance having a parallel width of 33 feet on each wide of said centre line as hereinbefore described; the noe South 57 degrees 18 minutes Sast, along a course 1040 feet to the intersection with the Easterly boundary of District Lot 214, being bounded along said course on the Horth by a line 33 feet distant from and parallel to said course and by the Southerly boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company's Right of Way, and on the South by a line Southerly and min distant 24.5 feet measured at right angles there to at the Westerly and and 19 feet at the Masterly and of said course; thence following the centre line of said road allow-

ance along the courses hereinafter described:-South 67 dogrees 18 minutes hast along a hangent 922.75 feet to the point of a curve to the left; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 819 feet, 196.6 feet to the intersection with a tangent; thence South 84 degrees Ol minutes That, along a tangent 763 feet to the point of a curve to the right; thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 104 feet, 81.7 feet to the intersection with a tangent; thence South 34 & grees 03 minutes last along a tangent 256.4 feet to the point of a curve to the left; thence along a curve to he left having a radius of 30% feet. 111.1 feet to the intersection with a tangent; thence douth 55 degrees 10 minutes last, along a tangent, 104.5 feet to the point of a curve to the left; thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 153.6 fest, 123.4 feet to the intersection with a tangent; thence Morth 77 degrees 55 mimutes Bast along a tangent 119 feet to the point of a curve to the right; thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 176 fast. 50 fast more or less to the intersection with the Easterly boundary of said District Lot 213; said point of intersection being Southerly and distant 789.76 feet from the post planted on the intersection of the Northerly boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company's Right of Way with said Easterly boundary of said District Lot 212, and said road allowance having a parallel distance of 3% feet along each side of seid centre line of read allowance as hereinbefore described and containing 8 11/100 seres be the same more or less as shown outlined in red on the plan attached herato.

4. The said lands in the preceding paragraphs two (3) and three (3) described may be conveyed to the Morth Pacific Sumber Company. Limited, in exchange for the lands required for said diversion and deed or doeds of said lands may be executed under the corporate scal of the said Corporation

of the District of Burnaby by the Reeve and Clark.

- 5. This By-law shall come into effect upon remeiving the consent of the Lieutenant-Towarnor in Council.
- This By-law may be cited as "HASAINGS-BARNET ROAD DIVERSION BY-LAW. 1914."
