

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 198.

A BY-LAW to provide for the raising of Revenue for General purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby in District Lot 172 (Extra Municipal).

WHEREAS by the "Public Schools Act" the Council of any City, Town or District Municipality in the Province are empowered in each and every year to pass a By-law or By-laws for levying a special rate of not more than five mills in the dollar for school purposes in addition to what is required for the payment of interest and sinking fund on any debt of the Municipality created for school purposes.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Public Instruction are empowered under the said "Public Schools Act" to create new School Districts in addition to those already in existence and to define the boundaries of existing Districts from time to time and to cancel the creation of School Districts.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Public Instruction by an order dated the 14th. day of March 1906 included in the Boundary of Burnaby Municipality for school purposes the whole of District Lot 172.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Act" and the "Public Schools Act", as follows:-

1. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1915 upon the assessed value of all wild taxable real property in District Lot One Hundred and Seventy-two (172) Group One (1) in the District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia as shown upon the last revised assessment roll thereof, all improvements being exempt altogether a tax of two and forty one-hundredths mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a). To provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby One and seventy one-hundredths mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(b). To provide for interest and sinking fund on One Hundred and Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$113,500.00) School

Board Debentures, and sinking fund only on Two Hundred and Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$216,000.00) School Board Debentures issued by the Municipality seventy one-hundredths mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".

2. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1915 upon the assessed value of all improved taxable real property in District Lot One Hundred and Seventy-two (172) Group One (1) in the District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia as shown upon the last revised assessment roll thereof, all improvements being exempt altogether, a tax of two and five one-hundredths mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a). To provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby one and seventy one-hundredths mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(b). To provide for interest and sinking fund on One Hundred and Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$113,500.00) School Board Debentures, and sinking fund only on Two Hundred and Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$216,000.00) School Board Debentures issued by the Municipality thirty-five one-hundredths mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".

3. The said taxation shall be payable at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, in the said Municipality on or before the 15th. day of July, 1915.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY SCHOOL BOARD (EXTRA MUNICIPAL) REVENUE BY-LAW 1915."

DONE AND PASSED in open Council the Tenth (10th.) day of May 1915.
