

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 202.

A By-law passed under the authority of Subsection 146 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act".

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. All manufacturers, keepers of slaughter-houses, shoddy-mills, crematories, canneries, rag or bone works, laundries, electric-light works, carpet-cleaners, chemical works, saw mills and other manufactories and works whose manufactories or other works are situate in the Municipality of Burnaby and the operation of which manufactories or other works may result in the production of smoke, dust or effluvia shall have such chimneys or other apparatus in connection with such manufactories or other works as shall consume the smoke, dust or effluvia or prevent the same from fouling the atmosphere or being carried by the wind or otherwise to other shops, houses or premises to the inconvenience or injury of the neighboring premises or residents therein.

2. Any person guilty of an infraction of this by-law shall, upon conviction thereof, before the Reeve, Police Magistrate, or any Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction within the said Municipality, be liable at the discretion of the said Reeve, Police Magistrate, Justice of the Peace convicting as aforesaid to a penalty not exceeding \$100.00 together with the costs of the prosecution and in default of payment forthwith, it shall be lawful for the Reeve, Police Magistrate, or Justice of the Peace convicting as aforesaid to issue a Warrant under his hand and seal to levy the said Penalty and costs by distress and sale of the offender's goods and chattels and in default of sufficient distress it shall and may be lawful for the Reeve,

Police Magistrate or Justice convicting as aforesaid to commit the offender to the common gaol or any lock-up house in the Municipality of Burnaby for any period not exceeding 30 days with or without hard labour unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY NUISANCES PREVENTION BY-LAW, 1915."
