

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

By-law No. 208.

A By-law to enable the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to provide for all sums which may be required for the lawful purposes of the Municipality and for School Board purposes for the year 1916, and for fixing the date upon which the Municipal Tax shall be payable in order to entitle a person to an abatement.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to pass a By-law for the above named purposes.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Act" as follows :-

1. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1916 upon the assessed value of all improved taxable real property in the said Municipality of Burnaby as shown upon the last revised assessment roll thereof, all improvements being exempt altogether, a tax of Fifteen (15) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a) To provide for interest only on Thirty-five Thousand---
-----Dollars (\$ 35,000.00) debentures,
and interest and sinking fund on One Million, One Hundred & Thirty-
eight Thousand Six Hundred & Fifty Dollars (\$ 1,138,650.00) debentures,
and sinking fund only on One Million, Five Hundred Thousand-----
-----Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) debentures
issued by the said Municipality, three and ten one-hundredths
(3.10) mills in the dollar to be called the "MUNICIPAL LOAN RATE".

(b) To provide for the general purposes of the Municipality Nine and twenty-one one-hundredths (9.21) mills in the dollar to be called the "GENERAL RATE".

(c) To provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby One and forty-two one-hundredths (1.42)

mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(d) To provide for interest and sinking fund on One Hundred and Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred-----Dollars (\$ 113,500.00.) school board debentures, and sinking fund only on Two Hundred and Sixteen Thousand--Dollars (\$ 216,000.00) school board debentures issued by the Municipality, thirty-four one-hundredths (.34) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".

(e) To provide for the payment of the proportion of the estimate for 1916 of the Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board forty-one one-hundredths (.41) mills in the dollar to be called the "VANCOUVER AND DISTRICTS JOINT SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE RATE".

(f) To provide for the payment of the interest and sinking fund on Fifty-five per cent (55%) of the cost of the Burnaby-Westminster Joint Sewer fifty-two one-hundredths (.52) mills on the dollar to be called the "BURNABY-WESTMINSTER JOINT SEWER RATE".

2. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1916 upon the assessed value of wild land in the said Municipality as shown by the last revised assessment roll thereof a tax of thirty-four (34) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a) To provide for interest only on Thirty-five Thousand---
-----Dollars (\$ 35,000.00) debentures, and interest and sinking fund on One Million, One Hundred & Thirty-eight Thousand, Six Hundred & Fifty Dollars (\$ 1,138,650.00) debentures, and sinking fund only on One Million, Five Hundred Thousand----- Dollars (\$ 1,500,000.00) debentures issued by the said Municipality, six and fifty one-hundredths (6.50) mills in the dollar to be called the "MUNICIPAL LOAN RATE".

(b) To provide for the general purposes of the Municipality twenty-four and forty-five one-hundredths (24.45) mills in the dollar to be called the "GENERAL RATE".

(c) To provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby one and forty-two one-hundredths (1.42) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(d) To provide for interest and sinking fund on One Hundred and Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred---Dollars (\$113,500.00) school board debentures, and sinking fund only on Two Hundred and Sixteen Thousand-----Dollars (\$ 216,000.00) school board debentures issued by the Municipality, seventy one-hundredths (.70) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".

(e) To provide for the payment of the proportion of the estimate for 1916 of the Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board forty-one one-hundredths (.41) mills in the dollar to be called the "VANCOUVER AND DISTRICTS JOINT SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE RATE".

(f) To provide for the payment ^{the} of interest and sinking fund on fifty-five per cent (55%) of the cost of the Burnaby-Westminster Joint Sewer Fifty-two one-hundredths (.52) mills on the dollar to be called the "BURNABY-WESTMINSTER JOINT SEWER RATE".

3. The said taxes shall be payable to the Collector at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, in the said Municipality, and the said Collector shall allow a rebate of One-sixth off the general rate if paid on or before the 30th. day of June, 1916, or a rebate of one-eighth off the general rate if paid on or before the 31st. day of August, 1916, or a rebate of one-tenth off the general rate if paid on or before the 31st day of October, 1916.

4. Provided, however, anything hereinbefore contained to the contrary notwithstanding the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) shall be the minimum taxation of any person or body of persons assessed in respect of real property within the Municipality.

5. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY REVENUE BY-LAW, 1916".
