A By-law confirming the sale of sertain debentures of the Municipality of Burnaby.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :-

- 1. That the sale of debentures deposited with The Equitable Trust Company of New York under "Burnaby Treasury Certificates (Series "A") By-law 1913" and "Burnaby freasury Certificates (Series "B") By-lew 1913" to the Royal Bank of Canada for the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1.300.000.00) be and the same is hereby confirmed.
- That the Rosve and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation to execute an assignment of the said debentures to the said Royal Bank of Canada in the form hereunto annexed or such other form as to them may seem expedient.
- This By-less may be cited as "BURNABY DEBENTURE SALE BY-LAW, 1916".
