

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

By-law No.....^{213.}

A By-law confirming the sale of certain debentures of the Municipality of Burnaby,

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows :-


1. That the sale of debentures deposited with The Equitable Trust Company of New York under "Burnaby Treasury Certificates (Series "A") By-law 1913" and "Burnaby Treasury Certificates (Series "B") By-law 1913" to the Royal Bank of Canada for the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00) be and the same is hereby confirmed.

2. That the Reeve and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation to execute an assignment of the said debentures to the said Royal Bank of Canada in the form hereto annexed or such other form as to them may seem expedient.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY DEBENTURE SALE BY-LAW, 1916".

WITNESSETH that in consideration of the sum of One Million Three Hundred thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00) now paid by the Bank to the Municipality (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) the Municipality doth hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the Bank its successors and assigns, all debentures issued by the Municipality to the aggregate amount of One Million Seven Hundred and sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$1,716,000.00) of which the following are particulars:-
