A By-law to repeal By-law No. 204 entitled "Burnaby Highway Abandonment By-law 1915".

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby on the 28th day of December, 1915, passed By-law No.204 entitled "Burnaby Highway Abandonment By-law 1915",


AND WHEREAS it has been discovered that there was an error in description of the road it was intended to close by said By-law and such error has been corrected in a new by-law of the said Municipality and it is desirable to repeal said By-law No. 204.


THE Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore enacts as follows :-

1. By-law No. 204 entitled "Burnaby Highway Abandonment By-law 1915" is hereby repealed.
2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY HIGHWAY ABANDONMENT BY-LAW 1915 REPEALING BY-LAW 1916".
