

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 215.

A By-law to amend By-law No. 201 entitled "Burnaby Street Traffic Regulation By-law 1915."

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. The interpretation clause of By-law No. 201 entitled "Burnaby Street Traffic Regulation By-law 1915" is hereby amended by striking out the words "for the purpose of the preceding section 'animal'" after the word "animal" in the sixth line of the second page of said by-law.

2. Section 19 of said By-law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:-

"It shall be unlawful for any person between dusk and dawn to use, drive, or propel in or upon any public place within the Municipality any vehicle unless the same shall be equipped with and shall carry a lighted lamp on the right-hand side thereof shewing a white light visible from the front at a distance of at least 100 feet, and such vehicle shall also display a red light visible from the rear, PROVIDED that this section shall not apply to bicycles, tricycles or motor-vehicles.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY STREET TRAFFIC REGULATION BY-LAW 1915 AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1916."
