Whereas it is necessary and desirable to borrow the sum of \$175,000.00 from The Royal Bank of Canada to meet the current lawful expenditure of the Corporation which becomes payable out of the annual revenue before the First day of December next:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, as follows:

- 1. That the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from The Royal Bank of Canada the sum of \$175,000.00.
- 3. That the said sum of \$175,000.00 shall be repayable on or before the 31st day of December next.
- 4. That the said sum together with interest theron, shall be payable out of the Municipal revenue for the current year.
- 5. That the obligation to be given therefor shall be a Promissory Note signed by the Mayor (if Reeve) and Finance Committee (if sup) and the Clerk of the Corporation, and shall bear the Corporate Seal of the Corporation.
