

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 221.

A BY-LAW to enable the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to provide for all sums which may be required for the lawful purposes of the Municipality and for School Board purposes for the year 1917 and for fixing abatement dates.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to pass a by-law for the above named purposes

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Act" and Amending Acts enacts as follows:-

1. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1917 upon the assessed value of all improved taxable real property in the said Municipality of Burnaby as shown upon the last revised Assessment Roll thereof, all improvements being exempt altogether, a tax of eighteen (18) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a). To provide for interest only on Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) debentures, and interest and sinking fund on One Million, Nine Hundred and Thirty-eight Thousand, Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1,938,650.00) debentures issued by the said Municipality, six and fifty one-hundredths (6.50) mills in the dollar to be called the "MUNICIPAL LOAN RATE".

(b). To provide for the general purposes of the Municipality seven and three one-hundredths (7.03) mills in the dollar to be called the "GENERAL RATE".

(c). To provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby two (2) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(d). To provide for interest and sinking fund on Three Hundred and Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$313,500.00) school board debentures issued by the Municipality, one and twenty one-hundredths (1.20) mills in the dollar to be called

the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".

(e). To provide for the payment of the proportion of the estimate for 1917 of the Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board sixty-seven one-hundredths (.67) mills in the dollar to be called the "VANCOUVER AND DISTRICTS JOINT SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE RATE".

(f). To provide for the payment of the interest and sinking fund on fifty-five per cent (55%) of the cost of the Burnaby-Westminster Joint Sewer sixty one-hundredths (.60) mills in the dollar to be called the "BURNABY-WESTMINSTER JOINT SEWER RATE".

2. There shall be raised and collected for the year 1917 upon the assessed value of wild land in the said Municipality as shown by the last revised assessment roll thereof a tax of thirty-eight mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a). To provide for interest only on Thirty-five thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) debentures, and interest and sinking fund on One Million, Nine Hundred and Thirty-eight Thousand, Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1,938,650.00) debentures issued by the said Municipality, fifteen (15) mills in the dollar to be called the "MUNICIPAL LOAN RATE".

(b). To provide for the general purposes of the Municipality seventeen and fifty-three one-hundredths (17.53) mills in the dollar to be called the "GENERAL RATE".

(c). To provide for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby two (2) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(d). To provide for interest and sinking fund on Three Hundred and Thirteen Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$313,500.00) school board debentures issued by the Municipality, two and twenty one-hundredths (2.20) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".

(e). To provide for the payment of the proportion of the estimate for 1917 of the Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board, sixty-seven one-hundredths (.67) mills in the dollar to be called the "VANCOUVER AND DISTRICTS JOINT

SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE RATE".

(f). To provide for the payment of the interest and sinking fund on fifty-five per cent (55%) of the cost of the Burnaby-Westminster Joint Sewer, sixty one-hundredths (.60) mills in the dollar to be called the "BURNABY-WESTMINSTER JOINT SEWER RATE".

3. The said taxes shall be payable to the Collector at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, in the said Municipality, and the said Collector shall allow a rebate of one-sixth off the general rate if paid on or before the 16th. day of July, 1917, or a rebate of one-eighth off the general rate if paid on or before the 15th. day of September, 1917, or a rebate of one-tenth off the general rate if paid on or before the 15th. day of November, 1917.

4. Provided, however, anything hereinbefore contained to the contrary notwithstanding the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) shall be the minimum taxation of any person or body of persons assessed in respect of real property within the Municipality.

5. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY REVENUE BY-LAW 1917".

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council the tenth (10th) day of April, 1917.
