CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

By-law No. 227.

A By-law to collect road tax within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS by subsection 168 of section 54 of the "Municipal Act" and amendments power is given to a district municipal pality to levy and collect road tax

and collected in the District of Burnaby

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. Save as hereinafter mentioned every person between the age of twenty-one and sixty residing for two weeks within the Municipality of Burnaby shall pay a road tax of Two Dollars (\$2.00) each year to the person duly authorized by the aforesaid Municipal Council to collect the same, subject to the other provisions of the said Municipal Act and amendments with reference thereto.

Provided that no officer, non-commissioned officer, gunner, private or member of any corps in the Province of British Columbia in the Active Militia Force of Canada, certified by the Officer Commanding the Corps to which such militiaman belongs or is attached, as being efficient, shall be liable to pay such read tax.

And provided further that no person who is the assessed owner of land a tuate within the said Municipality of Burnaby or who has paid the taxes for the current year on land in the said Municipality held by such person under an agreement to purchase, shall be liable to pay such road tax.

- 2. For the collection and recovery of the said tex the provisions of the "municipal not" and exendments therete shall apply and be used.
- 3. This Dy-low shall take effect from the date of its final possing.
- 4. "Burnaby Road Tax By-law 1916" is hereby repealed.
- 5. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURMABY ROAD TAX BY-L # 1917."
