## CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## Bylaw No. 234 ...

A Bylaw to amend "Burnaby Trades License Bylaw, 1911" The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. Clause seven (7) of Schedule "A" to " Burnaby Trades License Bylaw 1911" is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefore:-

7. "Transient Trader" shall mean a person who, on commencing the business of offering goods or merchandise of any description for sale by auction or otherwise in the municipality, and being requested by a municipal constable or by the clerk, collector, or license inspector of the municipality to give security to the municipality, in the amount of the license fee under this subsection, that he will carry on business as a trader in the municipality continuously for not less than six months, refuses or neglects to give such security to the satisfaction of the clerk, collector, or license inspector.

2. Clause sixteen (16) of said Schedule "A" to " Burnaby Trades License Bylaw 1911" is hereby amended by striking out the words " or land agent or both" in said clause.

3. This Bylaw may be cited as the "BURNABY TRADES LICENSE BYLAW 1911 AMENDMENT BYLAW 1918"
