

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

By-law No. 254.

A By-law to authorize the reconveyance to Jean Patterson of the Easterly 13 feet of Lots 8 and 9 of Lot 27, of Lots 1 and 3 of District Lot 95 Group 1, Map 1787.

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WHEREAS by Indenture dated the 20th. day of August 1913, Jean Patterson of the City of Vancouver in the Province of British Columbia, Spinster, conveyed to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby the lands and premises hereinafter described for the purpose of constructing or making a lane

AND WHEREAS the said lane has not been constructed or made and it is not now deemed advisable to construct or make

AND WHEREAS the said lands and premises are not required for corporate purposes

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That the easterly thirteen (13') feet of Lots 8 and 9 of Lot 27 of Lots 1 and 3 of Lot 95 Group One (1) New Westminster District as shown on plan No.1787 filed in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster B.C. be reconveyed to Jean Patterson of 24 Beaconsfield Apartments, 884 Bute Street Vancouver B.C. for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and that a conveyance of the said property to the said Jean Patterson, her heirs or assigns be executed under the seal of the Corporation by the Reeve & Clerk.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Patterson Reconveyance By-law 1919".
