BY-LAW NO. 267.

A BY-LAW to provide for the raising of revenue for general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby in District Lot 172 (Extra Municipal).

WHEREAS by the "Public School Act" it is provided that the Council of any Municipality shall in each and every year pass a By-law or By-laws for levying a special rate for school purposes,

AND WHEREAS the Council of Public Instruction is empowered under the said "Public Schools Act" to create new School Districts in addition to those already in existence and to define the boundaries of existing districts from time to time and to cancel the creation of School Districts.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Public Instruction by an order dated the 14th day of March, 1906, included in the boundary of Burnaby Municipality for school purposes the whole of District Lot 172.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Act" and the "Public Schools Act" enacts as follows:-

1. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1920 upon the assessed value of all wild and improved taxable real property in District Lot 172, Group 1, in the District of New Westminster and Province of British Columbia as shown upon the last revised assessment roll thereof, all improvements being exempt altogether, a tax of eight and three one-hundredths (8.03) mills in the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a). To provide for the general purposes of the

Board of School Trustees of Burnaby six and twenty onehundredths (6.20) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL RATE".

(b). To provide for interest and sinking fund on two hundred and ninety-four thousand three hundred Dollars (\$294.300.00) School Board debentures one and eighty-three one-hundredths (1.83) mills in the dollar to be called the "SCHOOL LOAN RATE".

2. The said taxes shall be payable at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, in the said Municipality.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the "BURNABY SCHOOL BOARD (EXTRA MUNICIPAL) REVENUE BY-LAW, 1920".

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this First (1st) day of March, 1920.
