

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 311.

WHEREAS by virtue of the provisions of the Poll Tax Act being Chapter 65 of the Statutes of British Columbia for the year 1917 and Amendments thereto, power is conferred upon Municipalities to levy an annual tax not exceeding Five (\$5.00) Dollars on resident male persons over the age of eighteen (18) years, with the exceptions contained in Section 4 of the said Act, the said tax to be applied for the benefit of hospitals and schools.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby enacts as follows:-

INTERPRETATION

1. In this By-law the following words shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them unless from the context a contrary intention should appear:-

"Corporation" shall mean the Corporation of the District of Burnaby.

"Collector" shall include the collector of taxes for the Municipality of Burnaby, and every person authorised by the Municipal Council of the Corporation to collect poll tax under this By-law.

"Male person" means a male person above the age of eighteen years who has resided in the Municipality of Burnaby for a period of one month during the current year.

"Employer of Labour" shall include merchants, farmers, traders, corporations and companies and every person who employs labourers, servants, clerks, domestics or hired help of any kind whatsoever, whether for wages, salary, fee or reward, or otherwise.

POLL TAX

2. Every male person in the Municipality of Burnaby shall pay an annual tax of Five (\$5.00) Dollars which tax shall be due from and after the Second (2nd) day of May, 1921, for the

year 1921, and from and after the Second (2nd) day of January in each and every year thereafter, and shall be payable in advance to the Collector for the use of hospital fees and schools.

3. Persons exempt under Section 4 of the Poll Tax Act 1917 and Amendments thereto shall be exempt from the payment of poll tax levied under this By-law.

4. The provisions contained in the Poll Tax Act of 1917 and Amendments thereto insofar as they relate to the levying and collecting of poll tax in Municipalities shall have the same force and effect as if the same were contained in this By-law.

THIS BY-LAW may be cited as "BURNABY POLL TAX BY-LAW, 1921."
