

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 317.

A BY-LAW to regulate the location, construction or use of piggeries within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS by subsection 127 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Council in every Municipality may make by-laws regulating the location, construction or use of piggeries which may if unrestricted as to location tend to reduce the value of assessable property,

AND WHEREAS by subsection 151 of said Section 54 the Council in every Municipality may make by-laws for preventing or regulating the keeping of pigs and defining limits within which the same may be kept,

AND WHEREAS certain districts within the Municipality of Burnaby may be considered residential districts and the location of piggeries within such residential districts would tend to reduce the value of assessable property,

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to regulate and prohibit the location, construction or use of piggeries within such residential districts and to prevent the keeping of pigs within such districts.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY therefore enacts as follows:-

1. The word "Piggery" wherever it appears in this by-law shall mean a location or premises where more than fifteen pigs are kept at one time.
2. The lands within the boundaries hereinafter defined shall be "Residential Districts" within the meaning of this by-law.
3. Residential District No. 1 shall be all the lands within the following described boundaries:

Commencing at the intersection of the North Road with the City limits of New Westminster; thence West to 10th Avenue; thence South-West along 10th Avenue to 6th Street; thence North to Mayfield Street; thence West to Douglas Road; thence

North-West to Cedar Street; thence East to the West boundary of D. L. 89; thence North to the South shore of Burnaby Lake; thence parallel to the shore of Burnaby Lake to Government Street; thence East to North Road; thence South along the North Road to the point of commencement.

4. Residential District No. 2 shall be all the lands within the following described boundaries:-

Commencing at the intersection of 6th Street and 10th Avenue; thence West along 10th Avenue to Mission Avenue; thence North to Kingsway; thence North along Sperling Avenue to Burris Street; thence North-East to Douglas Road; thence South along Douglas Road to Mayfield Street; thence East to 6th Street; thence South along 6th Street to the point of commencement.

5. Residential District No. 3 shall be all the lands within the following described boundaries:-

Commencing at the intersection of Mission Avenue and 10th Avenue; thence South-West along 10th Avenue to a point 1,000 feet South of Riverway; thence parallel to and 1,000 feet South of Riverway West to Royal Oak Avenue; thence North along Royal Oak Avenue to the South boundary of D. L. 84; thence East along the South boundary of D. L. 84 to Walker Avenue; thence South-East along Walker Avenue to Sperling Avenue; thence South along Sperling Avenue to Kingsway; and thence South along Mission Avenue to the point of commencement.

6. Residential District No. 4 shall be all the lands within the following described boundaries:-

Commencing at a point 1,000 feet South of the intersection of Riverway and Royal Oak Avenue; thence 1,000 feet distant from and parallel to Riverway West to Boundary Avenue; thence North along Boundary Avenue to the North boundary of D. L. 69; thence along the North boundary of D. L. 69, D. L. 70 and D. L. 73 to the Westerly boundary of D. L. 74; thence South along the Westerly boundary of D. L. 74 to Sprott Street; thence East along Sprott Street to Royal Oak Avenue; thence South to the point of commencement.

7. Residential District No. 5 shall be all the lands within the following described boundaries:-

Commencing at the intersection of the North Boundary of D. L. 69 with Boundary Avenue; thence North along Boundary Avenue to Burrard Inlet; thence East along the shore of Burrard Inlet to the Easterly boundary of D. L. 217; thence South along the Easterly boundary of D. L.'s 217, 206, 132 and 131 to Broadway; thence East along Broadway to the East boundary of D. L. 78; thence South along the East boundary of D. L. 78 to the Great Northern Railway; thence North-West along the Great Northern Railway to Sperling Avenue; thence North along Sperling Avenue to the South boundary of D. L. 131; thence West along the South boundaries of D. L.'s 131, 130, 125, 124, 119 and 118 to point of commencement.

8. Residential District No. 6 shall be all the lands within the following described boundaries:-

Commencing at the intersection of the West boundary of D. L. 89 with the South shore of Burnaby Lake; thence Westerly along the South shore of Burnaby Lake to the East boundary of D. L. 78; thence North along the East boundary of D. L. 78 to the Great Northern Railway; thence North-Westerly along the

South side of the Great Northern Railway to Sperling Avenue; thence North along Sperling Avenue to the North boundary of D. L. 77; thence Westerly along the North boundary of D. L. 77, D. L. 75 and D. L. 74 to the East boundary of D. L. 73; thence South along the West boundary of D. L. 74 to the South boundary of D. L. 74; thence Easterly along the South boundary of D. L. 74 to Royal Oak Avenue; thence South along Royal Oak Avenue to the South boundary of D. L. 84; thence East along the South boundary of D. L. 84 to Walker Avenue; thence South along Walker Avenue to Burris Street; thence East along Burris Street to Douglas Road; thence South along Douglas Road to Cedar Street; thence East along Cedar Street to the West boundary of D. L. 89; thence North to the point of commencement.

9. No person shall locate, construct or use a piggery in any one of the residential districts hereinbefore defined.

10. No person shall keep more than fifteen pigs at one time in any one location or premises within any one of the residential districts hereinbefore defined.

11. Any person violating any of the provisions of this By-law shall on summary conviction be liable to a penalty not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three (3) months.

12. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on its being finally passed and registered.

13. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PIGGERY LOCATION BY-LAW, 1921".
