

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 322.

A BY-LAW to amend the Cemetery By-law.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. Section 10 of By-law No. 239 entitled "Burnaby Cemetery By-law 1919" is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:-

"10. Unless the body is encased in stone or cement constructed to the approval of the Municipal Council no body shall be buried in any cemetery or graveyard in the Municipality except in such manner that there shall be at least four feet of earth between the top of the coffin containing such body and the surface of the surrounding ground and where two or more bodies are buried in one grave there shall be at least two (2) feet of earth between the coffins".

2. This By-law may be cited as "Burnaby Cemetery By-law 1919, Amendment By-law 1921".
