

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY.

BY-LAW NO. 323.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby from John F. Mahon.

WHEREAS John F. Mahon is the owner of 1.45 acre portion of Block Seven (7) District Lot One hundred and Twenty-five (125) Group One (1), New Westminster District, in the Province of British Columbia; which parcel may be more particularly known and described as follows:-

Commencing at a post planted on the Northerly boundary of Block 7 distant thereon Westerly from the S.E. corner of Block 5, in said D. L. 125, as shown on subdivision plan No. 3069 deposited in New Westminster Land Registry Office, 301.13 feet more or less, thence South  $22^{\circ}27'$  West 339.10 feet more or less to a post planted, thence South  $32^{\circ}18'30''$  West 323.66 feet more or less to a post planted on the Southerly boundary of said Block 7, thence North-westerly following the Southerly limit of Block 7 99.17 feet more or less to a point thereon perpendicularly distant 99 feet from the said preceding course South  $32^{\circ}18'33''$  West, thence North  $32^{\circ}18'30''$  East 320.67 feet more or less to a post planted, thence North  $22^{\circ}27'$  East 289.91 feet more or less to the intersection with the Northerly boundary of said Block 7, thence Easterly along the said Northerly boundary of Block 7 107.01 feet more or less to point of commencement, said parcel containing by admeasurement 1.45 acres, be the same more or less as shown outlined in red on plan attached hereto.

AND WHEREAS the said lands are required for corporate purposes

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of sub-section 27, of section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorized to make and pass by-law to acquire lands.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY THEREFORE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The 1.45 acre portion of Block Seven (7) District Lot One hundred and Twenty-five (125) Group One (1), New Westminster District, in the Province of British Columbia, shall be acquired from John F. Mahon, c/o. R. C. Procter, of 413 Granville Street, Vancouver, B. C., for corporate purposes.
2. On execution and delivery of conveyance by said John F. Mahon, by his attorney R. C. Procter, of 413 Granville

Street, Vancouver, B. C., to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby he shall be paid the sum of Six Hundred and Seventy (\$670.00) Dollars.

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

4. This By-law may be cited as "JOHN F. MAHON LAND PURCHASE BY-LAW 1921".
