BY-LAW NO. 342.

A BY-LAW to authorise the sale of certain Corporate lands to NORMAN CHARLES STEWART.

whereas the southerly sixteen and one-half (16k) feet of the northerly thirty-three (33) feet of Block Thirty-seven (37) of Lot Thirty-five (35) Group One (1) New Westminster District, in the Province of British Columbia, was acquired by the cancellation of a Subdivision Plan, dated the thirtieth (30th) day of June, 1919, which parcel may be more particularly known and described as follows:-

Commencing at a post planted sixteen and one-half (16%) feet south two degrees and thirteen minutes west of the north-west corner of Block Thirty-seven (37), thence south 88° 20' east 388.8 feet, more or less, thence south 1° 32' west sixteen and one-half $(16\frac{1}{2})$ feet, more or less, thence north 88° 20' west 389.0 feet, thence north 2° 13' east sixteen and one-half $(16\frac{1}{2})$ feet, more or less, to the point of commencement and containing 0.15 acres, more or less.

AND WHEREAS the said lands are no longer required for Corporate purposes.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

- 1. That the southerly sixteen and one-half (16%) feet of the northerly thirty-three (35) feet of Block Thirty-seven (37) of Lot Thirty-five (35) Group One (1) Map 799, be sold to Norman Charles Stewart, of 4363 Smith Avenue, Central Park, in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, British Columbia Land Surveyor, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.
- 2. That the Reeve and the Clerk be authorised to sign the Conveyance for the said lands, and to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as the "NORMAN C. STEWART PROPERTY BY-LAW, 1921".
