CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 343.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby from JOHN NEWMAN.

WHEREAS John Newman is the owner of Lot Four (4)
Block Twenty-five (25) of Lot Thirteen (13) Group One (1)
New Westminster District, Map 3046, in the Province of
British Columbia.

AND WHEREAS the said lands are required for corporate purposes,

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27, of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass by-law to acquire lands.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby therefore enacts as follows:-

- 1. Lot Four (4) Block Twenty-five (25) of Lot Thirteen (13) Group One (1) New Westminster District, Map 3046, in the Province of British Columbia, shall be acquired from John Newman, of Cassidy's, Vancouver Island, B. C., for corporate purposes.
- 2. On execution and delivery of Conveyance by said John Newman, of Cassidy's, Vancouver Island, B. C., to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby he shall be paid the sum of One Hundred and Ninety-five (\$195.00) Dollars.
- 3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.
- 4. This By-law may be cited as "JOHN NEWMAN PROPERTY BY-LAW, 1921".

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this Twenty-seventh (27th) day of December, 1921.
