

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 344.A

A BY-LAW to increase the number of members of the Council in the District of Burnaby.

WHEREAS by Section 14 of the "Municipal Act" the Council of a District Municipality may by by-law determine the number of members to which the Council of such Municipality shall consist provided that the number shall not be greater than eight,

AND WHEREAS the Council of Burnaby now consists of the Reeve and six Councillors,

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Burnaby is divided into six wards and it is desirable that there should be a Councillor representing what is known as the Broadview District and that the number of the members of the Council should be increased in order that the Broadview District should be represented in the Council.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby shall consist of the Reeve and seven Councillors.

2. Provided that before being finally passed this by-law requires the assent of the electors and shall take effect at the next ensuing annual Municipal Election 1923.

3. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY COUNCIL BY-LAW, 1921".
