

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 346.

A BY-LAW to amend the "Norman C. Stewart Property By-law, 1921".

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts, as follows:

1. That the first seven (7) lines of the first recitals in the "Norman C. Stewart Property By-law, 1921", being By-law No. 342 of this Corporation, be and is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:

"Whereas the southerly sixteen and one-half ($16\frac{1}{2}$) feet of the northerly thirty-three (33) feet of Block Thirty-seven (37) of Lot Thirty-five (35) Group One (1) New Westminster District, in the Province of British Columbia, was acquired by a Conveyance in fee from Ellen Lister, dated the Eleventh (11th) day of June, 1919, which parcel may be more particularly known and described as follows:-

Commencing at a post planted sixteen and one-half ($16\frac{1}{2}$) feet south two degrees and thirteen minutes west of the north-west corner of Block Thirty-seven (37), thence south $88^{\circ} 20'$ east 388.8 feet, more or less, thence south $1^{\circ} 32'$ west sixteen and one-half ($16\frac{1}{2}$) feet, more or less, thence north $88^{\circ} 20'$ west 389.0 feet, thence north $2^{\circ} 13'$ east sixteen and one-half ($16\frac{1}{2}$) feet, more or less, to the point of commencement and containing 0.15 acres, more or less."

2. This By-law may be cited as the "NORMAN C. STEWART PROPERTY BY-LAW, 1921, AMENDMENT BY-LAW, 1922".

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this Twenty-third (23rd) day of January, 1922.
