

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 357.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby did on the Fifteenth (15th) day of December, 1906, pass a By-law for the purpose of dedicating a road allowance thirty-three feet wide along the Easterly side of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127) Group One (1), from the Northerly boundary of Hastings Street to the Northerly boundary of said District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127),

AND WHEREAS a Subdivision Plan, dated December Twentieth (20th), 1907, of the East one-quarter of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127), Group One (1), was approved by the Municipal Council and duly deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, which said Plan showed the Easterly boundaries of Lots Thirteen (13) to Twenty-two (22) inclusive, in Block Two (2) of the said East one-quarter of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127) coincident with the Easterly boundary line of the said District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127),

AND WHEREAS a highway has been opened and public monies expended thereon by the Municipal Council upon the road allowance dedicated by the By-law passed on the Fifteenth (15th) day of December, 1906,

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the said road allowance should be acquired,

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands,

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That the following properties be acquired from the persons and for the amounts set opposite each parcel as follows:-

- (a) Lots Fourteen (14) and Fifteen (15) of Block Two (2) of the East one-quarter of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127), Group One (1) Map 1342, from Henry Booth, of Capitol Hill, in the Province of British Columbia, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.
- (b) The East thirty-three feet of each of Lots Sixteen (16) Seventeen (17) and Nineteen (19) of Block Two (2) of the East one-quarter of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127), Group One (1) Map 1342, from the North Coast Land Company, of 837 Metropolitan Building, in the City of Vancouver, and Province of British Columbia, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.
- (c) The East thirty-three feet of Lot Eighteen (18) of Block Two (2) of the East one-quarter of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127), Group One (1), Map 1342, from Sarah Large, wife of Joseph B. Large, of Capitol Hill, in the Province of British Columbia, for the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.
- (d) The East thirty-three feet of Lot Twenty (20) of Block Two (2) of the East one-quarter of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127), Group One (1), Map 1342, from Isabella McIntyre, Spinster, of 2358 Albert Street, in the City of Vancouver and Province of British Columbia, for the sum of Thirty-one Dollars and Seventy-five Cents (\$31.75).
- (e) The East thirty-three feet of Lot Twenty-one (21) of Block Two (2) of the East one-quarter of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-seven (127), Group One (1), Map 1342, from Duncan McIntyre, of Capitol Hill, in the Province of British Columbia, for the sum of Thirty-one Dollars and Seventy-five Cents (\$31.75).


- 2. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as the "HOLDOM AVENUE BY-LAW, 1922".
