BY-LAW, NO. 36

A BY-LAW to provide for the raising of Revenue for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby in District Lot 172 (extra municipal).

WHEREAS by the "Public Schools Act 1905, Amendment Act 1906" the Council of any City, Town or Rural Municipality in the Province are empowered in each and every year to pass a By-Law or By-Laws for levying a special rate of not more than ten (10) mills on the dollar for school purposes.

and whereas the Council of Public Instruction are empowered under the said Public Schools Act to create new School Districts in addition to those already in existence and to define the boundaries of existing districts from time to time and to cancel the creation of School Districts.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Public Instruction by an order dated the 14th. of March 1906 included in the boundaries of Burnaby Municipality for School purposes the whole of District Lot 172.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Clauses Act and the Public Schools Act 1905, Amendment Act 1906.

1. THERE SHALL BE RAISED, LEVIED, AND COLLECTED for the year 1909 upon the assessed value of all Wild and Improved taxable real property in District Lot 172 as shewn upon the last revised Assessment Roll thereof all improvements being exempt altogether a tax of three (3) mills on the dollar for the following purposes:-

(a) TO PROVIDE for the general purposes of the Board of School Trustees of Burnaby two and one half (2 1/2) mills on

the Dollar to be called the " School Rate."

- (b) TO PROVIDE for interest and sinking fund on Twelve thousand five hundred Dollars (\$12,500) School Board Debentures issued by the Municipality one half (1/2) mill on the Dollar to be called the "School Loan Rate."
- 2. THE SAID TAXES shall be payable at the Municipal Hall. Burnaby on or before the 30th. day of September 1909.

THIS BY-LAW may be cited for all purposes as the "Burnaby School Board (Extra Municipal) Revenue By-Law, 1909.

PASSED by the Council on the 31st. day of May 1909.

RECONSIDERED, and finally adopted, signed by the Reeve and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal on the 11th. day of June 1909.
