

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 361.

A BY-LAW to redivide the Municipality of Burnaby into Seven Wards on the basis of the assessed valuation.

WHEREAS By-law number 344-A of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby being a By-law to increase the number of members of the Council in the District of Burnaby, received the assent of the electors on the Fourteenth (14th) day of January, 1922,

AND WHEREAS the said By-law provides that the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby shall consist of the Reeve and seven (7) Councillors,

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to redivide the Municipality of Burnaby into seven (7) wards.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the "Municipal Act" enacts as follows:-

1. The Municipality of Burnaby shall be redivided into seven (7) Wards described and bounded as follows:-

(a) WARD ONE (1): Commencing at a point on the north shore of the North Arm of the Fraser River being the south west corner of D. L. 161; thence in an easterly direction following the north shore of the North Arm of the Fraser River to the point of intersection with the easterly boundary of D. L. 173; thence in a north westerly direction along the east boundary of D. L. 173 to the point of intersection of 10th Avenue; thence in an easterly direction following the south boundary of D. L. 171 to the south east corner of D. L. 171; thence in a north westerly direction along the easterly boundary of D. L. 171 to the north east corner of D. L. 171; thence north following the east boundary of D. L. 160 to the north east corner of said D. L. 160; thence west to the north west corner of D. L. 160; thence north following the easterly boundary of D. L. 97 to the north east corner of D. L. 97; thence west along the north boundaries of District Lots 97, 98, 99, 149 and 150 to the north west corner of D. L. 150 being its point of intersection with the west boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby; thence south along the west boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby being the centre line of Boundary Avenue to the north shore of the North Arm of the Fraser River being the south west corner of D. L. 161

and being the point of commencement and containing assessed property to the value of \$2,276,430., included in the following lots or portions of lots, namely:
District Lots 97, 98, 99, 149, 150, 155, 155A, 155B, 155C, 156, 157, 158, 159, 160, 161, 163, 162, 164, 165, 166, 166A, 167, 171, and 173, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality.

(b) WARD TWO (2): Commencing at the south west corner of D. L. 53 on the boundary line of the City of New Westminster and the Municipality of Burnaby; thence east along the south boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby to the south east corner of D. L. 28; thence in a north westerly direction following the easterly boundary of D. L. 28 to the north east corner of said D. L. 28; thence east along the south boundary of D. L. 90 to the south east corner of said D. L. 90; thence north west following the east boundary of D. L. 90 to the north east corner of said D. L. 90; thence north following the east boundary of D. L. 87 to its point of intersection with the south shore of Burnaby Lake; thence in a westerly and north westerly direction along the south shore of Burnaby to the north east corner of D. L. 85; thence south west following the centre line of Deer Lake Creek to the north west corner of D. L. 85; thence south east, south, and west along the shores of Deer Lake to its point of intersection with the west boundary of D. L. 85; thence south along the west boundaries of District Lots 85, 92 and 96 to the south west corner of said D. L. 96; thence east along the south boundary of D. L. 96 to the south east corner of said D. L. 96; thence south following the east boundary of D. L. 160 to the north east corner of D. L. 171; thence south east following the centre line of 20th Street to its intersection with the south east corner of D. L. 53 being the point of commencement and containing assessed property to the value of \$2,289,260., included in the following lots or portions of lots, namely:
District Lots 28, 29, 30, 53, 85, 86, 87, 90, 91, 92, 95, and 96, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality.

(c) WARD THREE (3): Commencing at the south west corner of D. L. 27; thence north easterly following the boundary line of the City of New Westminster and the Municipality of Burnaby to its point of intersection with the centre line of North Road; thence north following the easterly boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby to the south east corner of Block 2, D. L. 100; thence west following the south boundaries of Blocks 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, D. L. 100 and the north boundaries of District Lots 148, 143, 142, 137, 136 and 131, to the north west corner of said D. L. 131; thence south along the westerly boundary of D. L. 131 to the south west corner of said D. L. 131; thence east along the south boundary of D. L. 131 to its point of intersection with the centre line of Sperling Avenue; thence south along the centre line of Sperling Avenue to the south west corner of D. L. 78; thence east along the south boundary of D. L. 78 to its point of intersection with the west shore of Burnaby Lake; thence north, north east, and east along the north shore of Burnaby Lake to its point of intersection with the centre of Brunette Creek; thence south, south west, and west along the shores of Burnaby Lake to the north west corner of D. L. 89; thence south and south east following the west boundary of D. L. 89 to the south west corner of D. L. 89; thence south westerly along the north boundary of D. L. 27 to the north west corner of said D. L. 27; thence south easterly along the west boundary of D. L. 27 to the south west corner of D. L. 27 being the point of commencement and

containing assessed property to the value of \$2,306,605., included in the following lots or portions of lots, namely: District Lots 1, 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 25, 27, 40, 42, 43, 44, 56, 57, 58, 59, 78, 88, 89, 100, 131, 136, 137, 142, 143 and 148, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality.

(d) WARD FOUR (4): Commencing at the south west corner of D. L. 126; thence easterly following the south boundaries of District Lots 126, 129, 132, 135, 138, 141, 144, 147 and Blocks 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2, D. L. 100 to the point of intersection with the centre line of North Road being the easterly boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby; thence north following the easterly boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby to its intersection with the south shore of Burrard Inlet; thence westerly following the south shore of Burrard Inlet to its intersection with the north west corner of D. L. 189; thence south following the west boundaries of District Lots 189, 127 and 126 to the south west corner of D. L. 126, being the point of commencement and containing assessed property to the value of \$2,149,760., included in the following lots or portions of lots, namely: District Lots 31, 114, 100, 101, 102, 126, 127, 129, 132, 135, 138, 141, 144, 147, 189, 205, 206, 207, 208, 209, 210, 211, 212, 213, 214, 215, 216, 217, and 218, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality.

(e) WARD FIVE (5): Commencing at the south west corner of D. L. 117; thence east following the south boundaries of D. L. 117 and 120 to the south east corner of D. L. 120; thence north along the easterly boundary of D. L. 120 to the point of intersection with the centre line of Halifax Street; thence east along the centre line of Halifax Street to its intersection with the centre of Delta Avenue; thence north along the easterly boundary of D. L. 123, 122, and 188 to a point on the south shore of Burrard Inlet being the north east corner of D. L. 188; thence westerly along the south shore of Burrard Inlet to the north west corner of D. L. 186 being the north west corner of the Municipality of Burnaby; thence south following the west boundary of Municipality of Burnaby, to the south west corner of D. L. 117, being the point of commencement and containing assessed property to the value of \$2,197,460., included in the following lots or portions of lots, namely: District Lots 116, 117, 120, 121, 122, 123, 124, 186, 187 and 188, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality.

(f) WARD SIX (6): Commencing at the south west corner of D. L. 151; thence east following the centre line of Imperial Street to the south east corner of D. L. 93; thence north along the east boundaries of D. L. 93 and 84 to a point on the south shore of Deer Lake being the north east corner of D. L. 84; thence west and north, following the shores of Deer Lake to the point of intersection with the north boundary of D. L. 84; thence west following the north boundary of D. L. 84 to the north west corner of D. L. 84; thence south along the west boundary of D. L. 84 to the north east corner of D. L. 32; thence west along the north boundary of D. L. 32 to the north west corner of said D. L. 32; thence north along the east boundary of D. L. 33 to the north east corner of D. L. 33; thence west along the north boundary of D. L. 33 to the north west corner of D. L. 33; thence north along the east boundary of D. L. 34 to the north east corner of D. L. 34 being the point of intersection with the centre line of Moscrop Street; thence west along the centre line of Moscrop Street to the west boundary of the Municipality of

Burnaby being the centre line of Boundary Avenue; thence south following the westerly boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby to the south west corner of D. L. 151, being the point of commencement and containing assessed property to the value of \$2,133,255., included in the following lots or portions of lots, namely:
District Lots 32, 33, 34, 35, 84, 93, 94, 151, 152, and 153, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality.

(g) WARD SEVEN (7): Commencing at a point on Boundary Avenue being the intersection of the centre line of Moscrop Avenue and the western boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby; thence east following the centre line of Moscrop Street to the north east corner of D. L. 34; thence south following the east boundary of D. L. 34 to the north west corner of D. L. 33; thence east along the south boundary of D. L. 72, to the south east corner of D. L. 72; thence south along the west boundary of D. L. 82, to the south west corner of D. L. 82; thence east along the south boundary of D. L. 82 to the south east corner of D. L. 82; thence north along the east boundary of D. L. 82 to the south west corner of D. L. 83; thence east along the south boundary of D. L. 83 to its point of intersection with the shores of Deer Lake; thence north and east along the shores of Deer Lake to its point of intersection with the centre line of Deer Lake Creek being the south east corner of D. L. 79; thence north east along the centre line of Deer Lake Creek to its point of intersection with the shores of Burnaby Lake; thence north west, north, and north east along the shores of Burnaby Lake to the north east corner of D. L. 79; thence west along the north boundary of D. L. 79 to the south east corner of D. L. 77; thence north along the east boundary of D. L. 77 to the north east corner of D. L. 77; thence west along the north boundary of D. L. 77 to the south east corner of D. L. 130; thence north along the east boundary of D. L. 130 to the north east corner of D. L. 130; thence west along the north boundaries of D. L. 130 and 125 to the north west corner of D. L. 125; thence north along the centre line of Delta Avenue to its intersection with the centre line of Halifax Street; thence west along the centre line of Halifax Street to the point of intersection with the centre line of Queens Avenue; thence south along the centre line of Queens Avenue to the north east corner of D. L. 119; thence west along the north boundaries of D. L. 119 and 118 to the north west corner of D. L. 118 being its point of intersection with the west boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby; thence south along the westerly boundary of the Municipality of Burnaby to the point of intersection with the centre line of Moscrop Street being the point of commencement and containing assessed property to the value of \$2,133,150., included in the following lots or portions of lots, namely:
District Lots 35, 38, 39, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 79, 80, 81, 83, 82, 118, 119, 122, 123, 124, 125, and 130 according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the Municipality.

2. There shall be seven (7) Councillors for the Municipality, and one of such Councillors shall be elected from each of the said Wards.

3. In the interpretation of this By-law "North", "South", "East" and "West" shall be construed not in a strictly geographical sense but simply as indicating a general direction and as

following in that direction the boundary lines of a road or lot when a road or lot is mentioned with that intent.

4. The "Burnaby Ward Redivision By-law, 1914" is hereby repealed.

5. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY WARDS REDIVISION BY-LAW, NO. 2, 1922".

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this Fifteenth (15th) day of May, 1922.
