## CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

## BY-LAW NO. 365.

A BY-LAW to dedicate a Public Park in the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS the Council of any Municipality may under the provisions of Sub-Section 163 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", pass By-laws for accepting, purchasing, and holding real property for the purposes of public parks or pleasure grounds within or without the Municipal limits, and

WHEREAS Block "D" of District Lot One hundred and eighty-eight (188) Group One (1) Map 1586, was acquired by the Municipality at the 1917 Tax Sale, and

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that the said Block "D" of District Lot One hundred and eighty-eight (188) Group One (1) Map 1586, should be dedicated as a public park.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

- 1. All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land more particularly described as Block "D" of District Lot One hundred and eighty-eight (188) Group One (1) Map 1586, shall be and is hereby dedicated and reserved as a public park for the use and enjoyment thereof by the public.
- 2. The Parks Committee which may from time to time be appointed by the Council shall have jurisdiction over the said park and shall have power subject to the approval of the Council to make such regulations respecting the said park as may be deemed expedient.

This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY PARK DEDICATION BY-LAW, 1922".
