

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 370.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands,

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that a road allowance along the Easterly side of Block Eighteen (18) District Lot Twenty-nine (29) Group One (1), Map 3035, should be acquired,

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That the following property be acquired from Thomas Davies, of 13th Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, Florist, and Frank Davies, of Kingsway and 13th Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, Florist, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, that is to say:-

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby and more particularly known and described as portion of Block 18, District Lot 29, Group 1, District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, according to Map No. 3035, deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, and being more particularly described as follows:-

Commencing at the most Southerly corner of Block 18, D. L. 29, Group 1, New Westminster District according to Map number 3035 deposited, said point being on the North-easterly boundary of Kingsway and on the dividing line between Blocks 17 and 18; thence North-eastwardly and following the South-easterly boundary of said Block 18, 926.18 feet to the most Easterly corner of said Block 18; thence North-westwardly, and following, the North-easterly boundary of said Block 18, 16.5 feet to a post; thence South-westwardly, and parallel to the South-easterly boundary of said Block 18, 928.87 feet, more or less to an iron pin set on the aforsaid North-easterly boundary of Kingsway; thence South-eastwardly and following the said

North-easterly boundary of Kingsway, 16.7 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement and containing, by admeasurement, 0.351 of an acre, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "THOMAS AND FRANK DAVIES PROPERTY PURCHASE BY-LAW, 1922".

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this Seventeenth (17th) day of July, 1922.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed this Twenty-fourth (24th) day of July, 1922.
