

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 386.

A BY-LAW to dedicate certain street allowances within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 186 of Chapter 52 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make By-laws for establishing, opening, making, preserving, improving, repairing, widening, altering, diverting or stopping up roads, streets, squares, alleys, lanes, bridges or other public thoroughfares,

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that certain lands should be dedicated for the purpose of street allowances in the Municipality of Burnaby.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That the following parcels of land shall be and are hereby dedicated for street purposes, that is to say:-

- (a) The East Thirty-three (33) feet of Lot Three (3) of Block "H" of Lot One hundred and eighteen (118), Group One (1) Map 3067.
- (b) A portion of Block Fifteen (15) in the Central Portion of Lot Ninety-one (91), Group One (1), Map 535, more particularly described as follows:- Commencing at an iron pin set on the Southeasterly Boundary of Block 15, in the Central Portion of Lot 91, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to Map number 535, deposited, said iron pin being 33 feet, N. 51°05' E. Ast., from the most Southerly corner of said Block 15; thence south-westwardly, and following the said Southeasterly Boundary of Block 15, 33.0 feet to the most Southerly corner of Block 15, aforesaid; thence Northwestwardly, and following the Southwesterly Boundary of said Block 15, 165.0 feet, more or less, to the most Westerly corner of said Block 15; thence Northeastwardly and following the Northwesterly Boundary of said Block 15, 52.71 feet; thence Southeastwardly, 166.0 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement and containing, by admeasurement, 0.162 of an acre, be the same more or less, as more particularly shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour.

(c) A portion of Blocks Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) of Lot Eleven (11), Group One (1) Map 3045, more particularly described as follows:-
Commencing at the most Westerly corner of Block 29 in the subdivision of Lot 11, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to Map Number 3045, deposited, said point of commencement being at the intersection of the Northwesterly and Southwesterly Boundaries of said Block 29; thence N.50°29'E. and following the Northwesterly Boundaries of Blocks 29 and 30, 503-6 feet to the most Northerly corner of said Block 30; thence S.39°12'E., and following the Northeasterly Boundary of said Block 30, 33.0 feet to a post; thence S.50°29'W. and parallel to the Northwesterly Boundaries of Blocks 30 and 29, aforesaid, 503.66 feet, more or less, to a post set on the Southwesterly Boundary of said Block 29; thence N.39°04'W. and following the said Southwesterly Boundary of Block 29, 33.0 feet to the point of commencement and containing, by admeasurement, 0.381 of an acre, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY STREETS DEDICATION BY-LAW, 1923".
