

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 391.

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By-law, 1912".

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. The Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By-law, 1912, being By-law No. 134 of this Corporation is hereby amended by repealing Section 21 thereof, and substituting the following therefor:-

(21). (a) When any service has been disconnected from any premises at the request of the consumer, or of the owner of the premises, the Council may require payment of a fee not exceeding fifty (50) cents, before ordering the service to be resumed.

(b) When any service has been disconnected from any premises for non-payment of rent or rate or infringement of terms or of this By-law, the Council may require payment of a fee not exceeding One (\$1.00) Dollar, before ordering the service to be resumed.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY WATERWORKS REGULATION BY-LAW, 1912, AMENDMENT BY-LAW, 1923".
