## BY-LAW 1NO. 392.


#### Abstract

A BY-LAW to authorise the Corperation of the District of Burnaby to aaquire an Easemont for Corporate purposes.


WHERRAS it is desirable and expedient thet en Rasement should be acquired for drainage purposes acrese the lands deacribed as pertion of Lot Thirty-two (32) Blook Fiftean (15) Contral fortion of Lot Twenty-eight (28) Greup One (1);

AND WHRRAS James Fotheringham is the owaer in fee, and Willism Flumerfelt is the helder of the Agreement for Sale, of the said lands;

AMD WIERRES under the provisions of Sub-section 27, of Section 54 of the menicipal act", the Manicipal Council is anthorised to make and pass a by-law to aequire lands;

THERBFORE the Munioipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby onacts, as follows:-

1. It ghall be lawful for the Manicipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Basement from James Fotheringham, of 633, 10 th Avenue, Hew Wegtminster, B. C., and Wiliam Flumerfelt, of 15 th Avenue, Burnaby, B. C. for drainage purposea acrosa portion of Lot Thirty-two (32) Block fifteon (15) Contral portion of Lot Pwenty-eight (28) Group One (1), which pareel may be more partieularly deseribed, as followz:-

Commenaing at a point on the Southossterly Boundary of Lot 32, Blook 15. Contral Portion of Lot 28, Group 1, How Weatminster Distriot, according to Kap Mumber 627 deposited. geid peint of commencement being on the centre line of a ditoh now constructed acrose said Lot 32 and 148.9 feet, H. $51^{\circ} 02^{\prime} 30^{\circ} \mathrm{E}$ from the point of intersection of the contre Line of Sixth Street. City of Now Hestminster, produced, with the Horthwesterly Boundary of Fifteenth Avenue, Burnaby, produced;

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thence No. \(19^{\circ} 50^{\prime} 30^{\circ} \mathrm{W}\), fAst., 105.74 feet to an iron pin set;
thence N. 39024'W. Astr., 20.09 feet, more or less, to an iron
pin set on the Northwesterly Boundary of Lot 32, aforesaid.
The above described line to be the centre Line of a
strip of land, two feet in width and being bounded on the
South by the Southeasterly Boundary of Lot 32, aforesaid, and
on the North by the Northwesterly Boundary of said Lot 32 ,
as more particularly shown on the plan hereunto annexed and
thereon outlined in red colour.
Paying therefor the sum of One ( 4.00 ) Dollar of lawful money
of Canada.
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2. This By-law may be cited as the MJ. FOMERINGHAM EASEMENT BY-LAWF, 1923".
