

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 408.

A BY-LAW to authorise the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that an Easement should be acquired for drainage purposes across the lands described as a portion of Blocks 27 and 46, in the subdivision of Lot 83, Group 1, Map 1267;

AND WHEREAS Francis William Eccles is the owner in fee of the said lands;

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27, of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass a by-law to acquire lands;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts, as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement from Francis William Eccles, of 736 Granville Street, Vancouver, B. C., for drainage purposes across a portion of Blocks Twenty-seven (27) and Forty-six (46) in the subdivision of Lot Eighty-three (83), Group One (1), Map 1267, which parcel may be more particularly described, as follows:-

Commencing at a post set on the North Boundary of Block 27, in the subdivision of Lot 83, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to Map Number 1267 deposited, 6.0 feet East of the Northwest corner thereof; thence Southwardly and parallel to the West boundary of said Block 27, 553.2 feet, more or less, to a post set on the South boundary of said Block 27 and 6.0 feet East of the Southwest corner thereof; thence Southwardly and parallel to the West Boundary of Block 46, in the subdivision of Lot 83, aforesaid, 555.5 feet, more or less, to a post set on the South boundary of said Block 46 and 6.0 feet East of the Southwest corner thereof; thence Westwardly and following the South boundary of said Block 46, 4.0 feet to a post; thence Northwardly and parallel to the West boundary of said Block 46, 555.5 feet,

more or less, to a post set on the North boundary thereof; thence Northwardly and parallel to the West boundary of Block 27, aforesaid, 553.2 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the North boundary of said Block 27; thence Eastwardly and following the North boundary of said Block 27, 4.0 feet to the point of commencement as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour.

Paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar of lawful money of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "F. W. ECCLES EASEMENT BY-LAW, 1924."

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this Seventh (7th) day of January, 1924.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed this Twenty-fourth (24th) day of January, 1924.

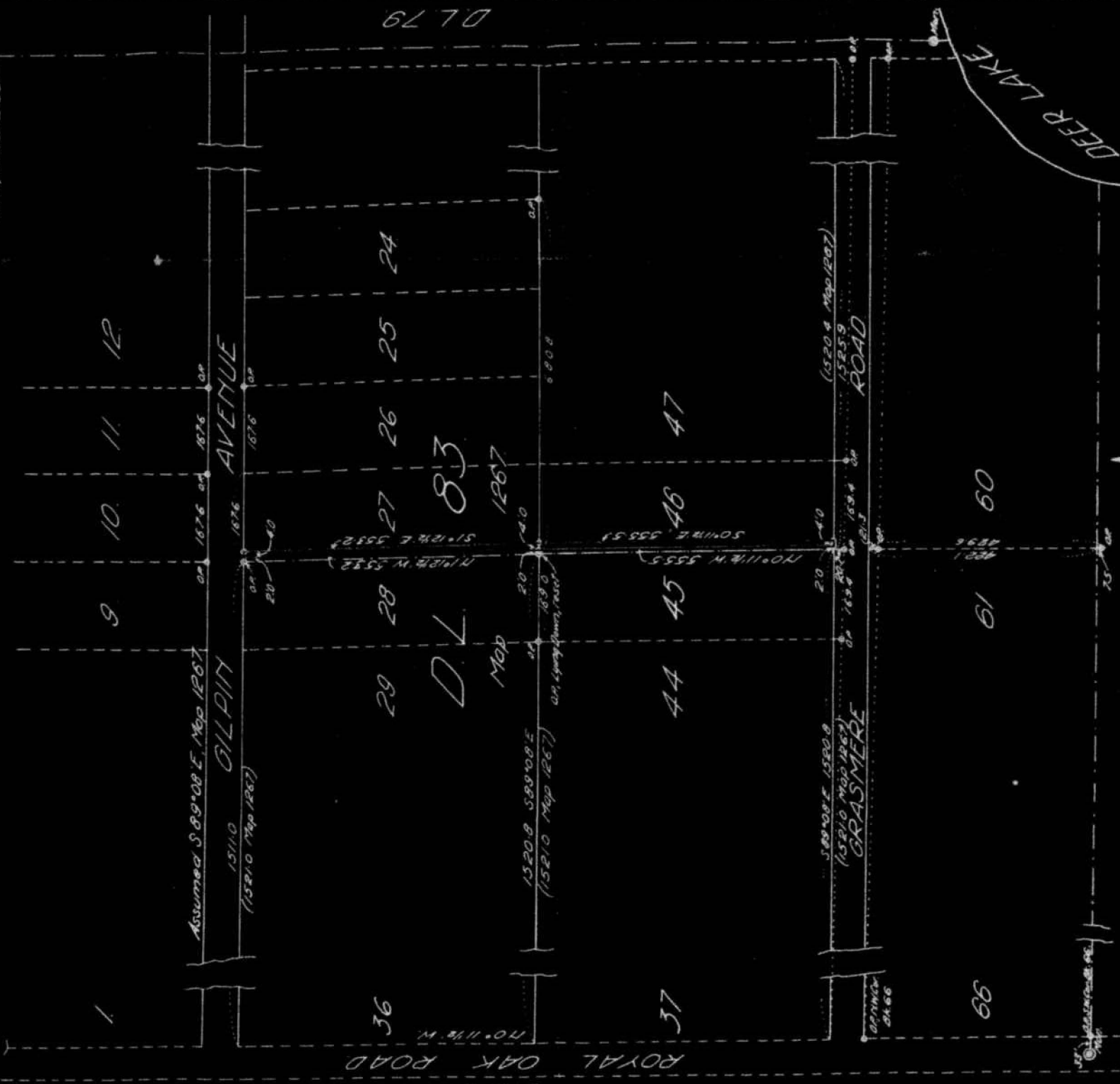
