

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 411.

A BY-LAW to dedicate a certain street allowance within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 186 of Section 54 of Chapter 52 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorized to make by-laws for establishing, opening, making, preserving, improving, repairing, widening, altering, diverting or stopping up roads, streets, squares, alleys, lanes, bridges or other public thoroughfares,

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that certain lands should be dedicated for the purpose of a street allowance in the Municipality of Burnaby.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. That the following parcel of land shall be and is hereby dedicated for street purposes, that is to say:-

A portion of Block Nineteen (19) in the subdivision of Lot Forty-four (44) Group One (1), (according to Map number 3049 deposited in the Land Registry Office at New Westminster, B. C.), District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly described as follows:-

Commencing at the North-east corner of Block 19, in the Subdivision of Lot 44, Group 1, New Westminster District, according to Map number 3049, deposited; thence Northwestwardly and following the Northeastly boundary of said Block 19 and the Southwestly boundary of the Right-of-Way of the V.V. and E. Rly. and Nav. Coy., 2371.09 feet, more or less, to an iron pin

set 106.2 feet S 38° 05'30" E, from the Northwest corner of said Block 19, said point being on the East boundary of a 66 foot road as shown on plan attached to Filing Number 11774; thence S 0° 19' W, and following the East boundary of said Road, 53.1 feet to a post; thence Southeastwardly, parallel to and 33.0 feet distant from the Northeastly boundary of Block 19, aforesaid, 2359.84 feet, more or less, to a post set on the East boundary of said Block 19; thence Northwardly and following the said East boundary of Block 19, 35.3 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement and containing, by admeasurement, 1.796 acres, be the same more or less, as shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon outlined in red colour.

2. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

3. This By-law may be cited as the "BURNABY STREET DEDICATION BY-LAW, 1924.
