

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 414.

A BY-LAW to authorise the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that an Easement should be acquired for the purpose of a water line along the lands described as a portion of Block "D" of Block Two (2) of Lot Twenty-nine (29) Group One (1), Map 3035;

AND WHEREAS Joseph Alexander Macneill is the owner in fee of the said lands;

AND WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27, of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act", the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass a By-law to acquire lands;

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts, as follows:-

1. It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to acquire an Easement from Joseph Alexander Macneill, of 11339 South Irving Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, U.S.A., for the purpose of a water line along a portion of Block "D" of Block Two (2) of Lot Twenty-nine (29) Group One (1), Map 3035, which parcel may be more particularly described, as follows:-

Commencing at a point on the Northwesterly boundary of Block "D", of Block 2, of District Lot 29, Group 1, New Westminster District, said point being 194.6 feet Northeastwardly from the most Northerly corner of Lot 11, Block 2, aforesaid, according to Map Number 3035, deposited; thence Southeastwardly, perpendicular to the Northwesterly boundary of said Block "D" and being S 39° 43' 30" E. Ast., a distance of 42.43 feet; thence S. 72° 43' 30" E. Ast., a distance of 48.6 feet; thence S. 39° 43' 30" E. Ast., a distance of 30.32 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the Southeasterly boundary of Block "D", aforesaid.

The above described line being the centre line for a strip of land, running from the Northwesterly to the South-easterly boundary of said Block "D" with a perpendicular width of 12 feet, 6 feet on either side of the said centre line.

Paying therefor the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar of lawful money of Canada.

2. This By-law may be cited as the "JOSEPH A. MACNEILL EASEMENT BY-LAW, 1924."

DONE AND PASSED in open Council this Fourth (4th) day of February, 1924.

RECONSIDERED and finally passed this Eighteenth (18th) day of February, 1924.
