

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 427.

A BY-LAW to amend the Waterworks Regulation  
By-law, 1912.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District  
of Burnaby enacts, as follows:-

1. The Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By-law, 1912,  
being By-law No. 134 of this Corporation is amended by repealing  
Section 4 thereof, and substituting the following therefor:-

(Section 4) The rate to be paid by consumers to the  
Corporation for water shall be at the rate of Seven (\$7.00)  
Dollars for every period of six (6) months commencing on the  
first (1st) day of January and the first (1st) day of July,  
respectively, in each and every year, provided that if the  
consumer pays to the Corporation the amount due to the Corporation  
promptly on or before the thirty-first (31st) day of January and  
the thirty-first day of July, in each and every year, the rate  
payable shall be reduced to Six (\$6.00) Dollars.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY WATERWORKS  
REGULATION BY-LAW, 1912, AMENDMENT BY-LAW, 1924."
