

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 429.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that a thirty-three (33') feet road allowance along Block Twenty-four (24) District Lot Twenty-nine (29) Group One (1) Map No. 3035, should be acquired.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. The Northerly thirty-three (33') feet of Block Twenty-four (24) of District Lot Twenty-nine (29) Group One (1) Map 3035, New Westminister District, in the Province of British Columbia, shall be acquired from William McCurraoh, of 1049, 14th Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, for Corporate purposes, which parcel may be more particularly described, as follows:-

Commencing at a post set at the North West corner of Block 24, District Lot 29, Group 1, New Westminister District, according to Map 3035 deposited at the Land Registry Office at New Westminister; thence N58°57'E (Ast.) and following the northerly boundary of said Block 24, 181.5 feet, more or less, to a post set at the North East corner of said Block 24; thence S39°12'30"E (Ast.) and following the Easterly boundary of said Block 24, 33.0 feet to a post; thence S58°57'W (Ast.) and parallel to the Northerly boundary aforesaid, 181.5 feet, more or less, to a post set on the Westerly boundary of Block 24 aforesaid; thence N39°12'30"W (Ast.) and following the said Westerly boundary, 33.0 feet to the point of commencement, and containing by admeasurement, 0.137 acres, be the same more or less, as more particularly shown on the plan hereunto annexed and thereon surrounded with red colour.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyance by said William McCurraoh, of 1049, 14th Avenue, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, he shall be paid the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

4. This By-law may be cited as "WILLIAM McCURRACH PROPERTY BY-LAW, 1924."
