

CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 430.

A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that a road allowance along Lot Four (4) Block Thirty-five (35) of District Lot Thirteen (13) Group One (1) Map 3046, should be acquired.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts, as follows:-

1. Lot Four (4) Block Thirty-five (35) of District Lot Thirteen (13) Group One (1) Map 3046, New Westminster District, in the Province of British Columbia, shall be acquired from Margaret P. Bulkley, wife of George Bulkley, of 2495, 13th Avenue, West, in the City of Vancouver, and Province of British Columbia, for Corporate purposes.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyance by said Margaret P. Bulkley, wife of George Bulkley, of 2495, 13th Avenue, West, in the City of Vancouver, and Province of British Columbia, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, she shall be paid the sum of Two Hundred and Seventy-six Dollars and Seventy-four Cents (\$276.74).

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

4. This By-law may be cited as "MARGARET P. BULKLEY PROPERTY BY-LAW, 1924."
