



CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 458.

A BY-LAW to enable the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to provide for all sums which may be required for the Burnaby Fire Area No.1. 1925, for the year 1925.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to pass a By-law for the above named purpose.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act and Amending Acts enacts as follows:-

1. There shall be raised, levied and collected for the year 1925 upon the assessed value of all property liable to destruction by fire in the Burnaby Fire Area No.1. as shown upon the last revised assessment roll thereof, a tax of three and thirty eight one-hundredths (3.38) mills in the dollar for the following purpose.

To provide for interest and sinking fund on Five thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars debentures issued by the said Municipality, three and thirty eight one-hundredths (3.38) mills in the dollar to be called the "BURNABY FIRE AREA NO.1. 1925. LOAN RATE"

2. There shall be raised and collected for the year 1925 upon the assessed value of the land and improvements in the Burnaby Fire Area No.1. as shown by the last revised assessment roll thereof a tax of eighty one-hundredths (.80) mills in the dollar for the following purpose.

To provide for the housing, maintenance and operation of the fire apparatus provided for the said Fire Area, eighty one-hundredths (.80) mills in the dollar to be called the "Burnaby Fire Area No.1. 1925 Maintenance rate"

3. The said taxes shall be payable to the Collector at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, in the said Municipality.

4. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Fire Area No.1. Rates By-law 1925"

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Thirtieth (30th) day of March, 1925.
