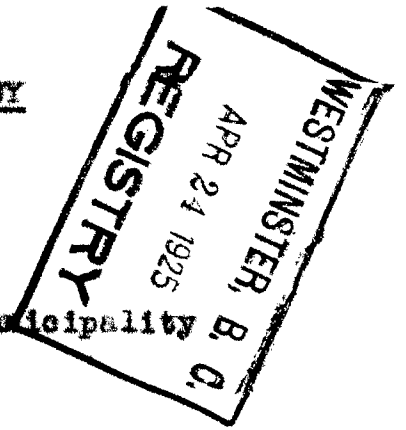


CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 460.



A BY-LAW to acquire lands within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Sub-section 27 of Section 54 of the "Municipal Act" the Municipal Council is authorised to make and pass By-laws to acquire lands:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable and expedient that Lot Three (3) District Lot Seventeen hundred and thirty one (1731), Group One (1) Map 4082, Vancouver District and East half of Lot Two (2) of Block Eight (8) of Lot Ninety three (93) Group One (1) Map 1525, in the District of New Westminster, should be acquired.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby enacts as follows:-

1. Lot Three (3) District Lot Seventeen hundred and thirty one (1731) Group One (1) Map 4082, Vancouver District, in the Province of British Columbia, and East half of Lot Two (2) of Block Eight (8) of Lot Ninety-three (93) Group One (1) Map 1525, in the District of New Westminster, Province of British Columbia, shall be acquired from Margret Ann Thomas, of 2623 Windsor Street, in the Municipality of Burnaby, and Province of British Columbia, Widow, for Corporate purposes.

2. On execution and delivery of Conveyances of the said parcels by the said Margret Ann Thomas, Widow, of 2623 Windsor Street, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, she shall be paid the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar in respect of each of the said parcels.

3. This By-law shall take effect upon its being finally passed.

4. This By-law may be cited as "MARGRET ANN THOMAS
PROPERTY BY-LAW, 1925."
