A BY-LAW to authorise the execution of an agreement with the City of Vancouver,

1. Authority is hereby given to the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to sign, execute and affix the Corporate seal to and give delivery to the City of Vancouver therein named of an agreement between the Corporation of the District of Burnaby and the said City of Vancouver all to the extent on the terms and in the manner set forth in the said agreement a copy whereof is hereto annexed and that all as an act and deed of the said Corporation.

2. This By-law may be cited as "CITY OF VANCOUVER BURWELL LAKE WATER SUPPLY AGREEMENT BY-LAW, 1925"

AGREEMENT made in duplicate and entered into this Ninth (9th) day of Aune in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty five (A.D. 1925) BETWEEN:

> CITY OF VANCOUVER (Hereinafter called the "City")

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY (Hereinafter called the"District") OF THE SECOND PART:

WITNESSETH that the parties hereto, insofar as they are thereunto enabled, mutually covenant and agree as follows:

1. It is understood and agreed between the City and the District that the District will contribute onetwelfth of the total cost of and incidental to the construction of a tunnel at Burwell Lake for the purpose of regulating the storage and flow of watersupply from Burwell Lake into Seymour Creek, which it is proposed between the parties hereto that the City shall construct at an early date, the approximate cost of which is estimated to be Fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars.

2. The District agrees to pay to the City the sum representing one-twelfth of such total cost of such tunnel forthwith on demand on completion of the said work.

3. It is further understood and agreed between the parties hereto that the agreement for the supply of water entered into between the City and the District, dated June 5th. A.D. 1911, shall remain in full force and effect, and nothing herein contained shall affect or vary the same.
