BY-LAW NO. 467.

A By-law to bring into force in the Municipality of Burnaby Subdivision (b) of Division 3 of Part 2 of the "Municipal Act" relating to maternity and infant homes.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 78 of the "Municipal Act" being Chapter 179 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1924 that the Council of any municipality may by by-law declare that from and after the passing of such by-plaw Subdivision (b) of Division 3 of Part 2 of the "Municipal Act" otherwise known as Sections 78 to 93 inclusive shall be in force in the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Council considers it advisable that the said provisions be brought into force in the Municipality of Burnaby.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. It is hereby declared that from and after the passing of this by-law Subdivision (b) of Division 3 of Part 2 of the "Municipal Act" being Chapter 179 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1924 otherwise known as Sections 78 to 93 inclusive shall be in force in the Municipality of Burnaby.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY MATERNITY AND INFANT HOMES BY-LAW 1925."
